

York Corridor BID Small Business Camera Program

Program Overview

The York Corridor Business Improvement District Management Authority (York Corridor BID) Small Business Camera Program is a new grant opportunity for small businesses and commercial property owners located within the York Road Commercial Corridor (see map). The purpose of the program is to pay for costs and coordinate the installation of security cameras along the Corridor, with the goal of improving safety outcomes for businesses and residents. Funds can support the installation of security cameras on both the interior and exterior of small businesses.

Process

The York Corridor BID's Small Business Camera Program includes two different options to support the installation of security cameras:

Option 1. York Corridor BID processes refund to applicant for approved cost of security camera purchase and installation, coordinated by applicant (max rebate \$2,500)

NOTE: Costs for which applicant seeks reimbursement must be approved in advance by York Corridor BID, and must be completed by a licensed contractor. The BID can assist with identifying contractors and soliciting estimates, if needed.

Option 2. York Corridor BID manages contract to install cameras, with <u>no upfront payment from applicant</u> (max project cost \$2,500)

NOTE: Applicant must agree to sign over responsibility to York Corridor BID to execute a contract on the applicant's property. This is necessary in order to facilitate direct payments to contractors. Final plans and designs are subject to approval by applicant before contract signature with installer.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the York Corridor BID's Small Business Camera Program, you must...

- Currently own and operate a small business located along York Road, between Northern Parkway and 41st Street (see map). Both building renters and owners are eligible to apply.
- Agree to register all newly installed exterior cameras with the CitiWatch Community Partnership.
- Be able to obtain written consent to the final project plan from building owner (if different from applicant).
- Comply with all applicable local, state and federal laws, as well as all local, state and federal statutes governing fair leasing practices and equal employment opportunities.
